Tests We Offer:

- Electromyography/Nerve Conduction Studies (EMG/**N**CS)
 - Upper and Lower Extremities
 - Cranial Nerve Testing (Facial, Trigeminal)
 - Paraspinal muscles

We recommend NCS and EMG be done together:

NCS testing alone may miss several important disease states

- Repetitive Stimulation (Neuromuscular Junction **T**est)

To Evaluate:

- Entrapment neuropathies and plexopathies: Carpal **t**unnel syndrome, Tarsal tunnel syndrome, Cubital tunnel syndrome, Thoracic **o**utlet syndrome, and etc.
- Nerve injuries (Testing will provide diagnostic and **p**rognostic information)
- Radiculopathies
- Polyneuropathies
- Myopathies
- Motor neuron disease (ALS)
- Neuromuscular junction disorders (Myasthenia **g**ra^vis)
- Bell's palsy (Prognostic information)
- Unexplained numbness, tingling, or weakness
