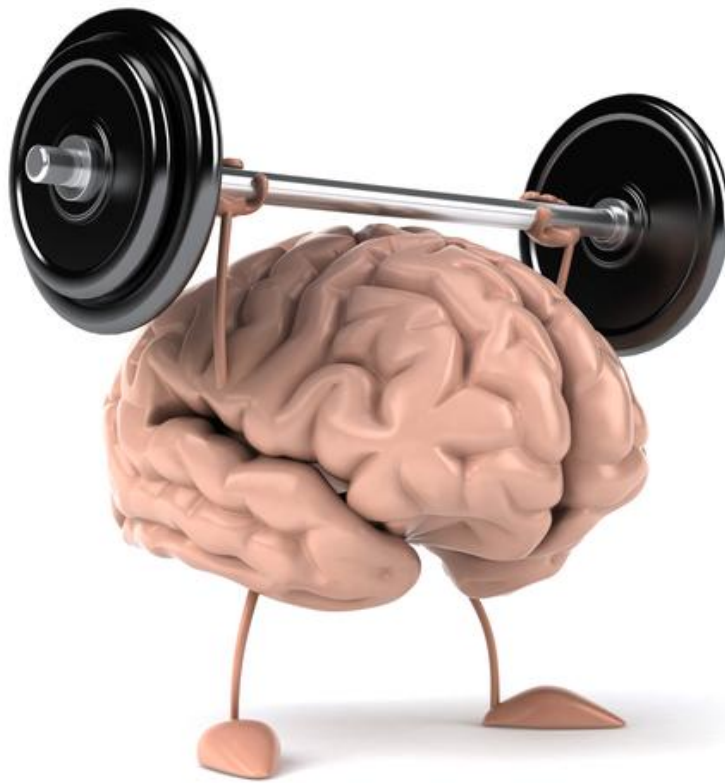

**The weapon was used in his family's backyard.**

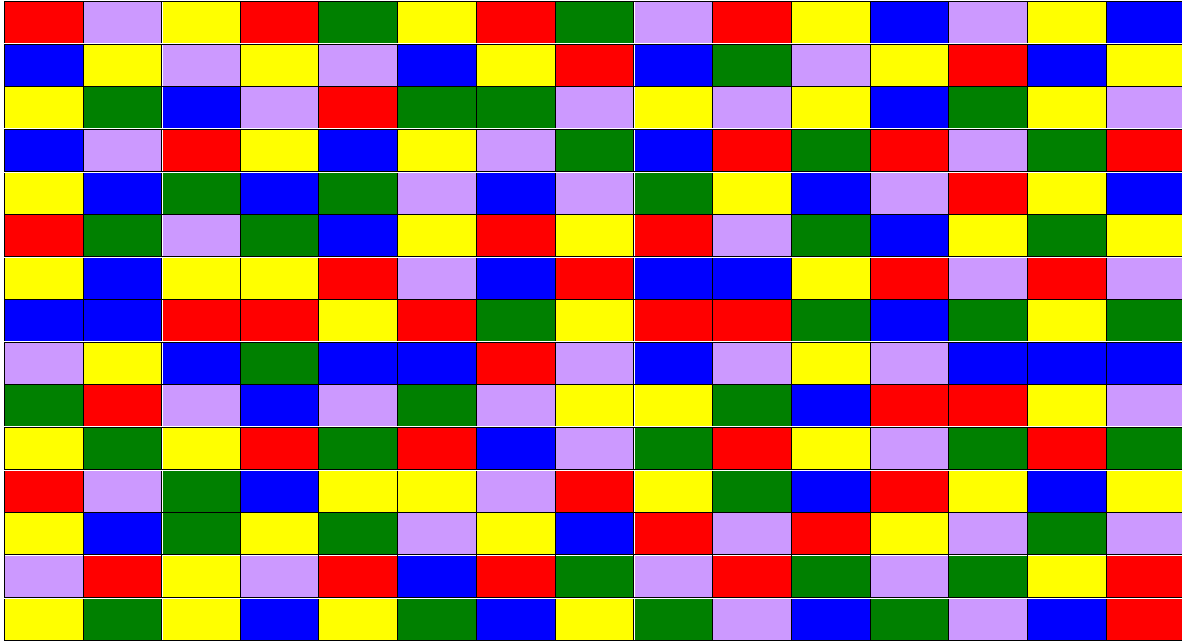
**The man has a U.S. city named after him.**

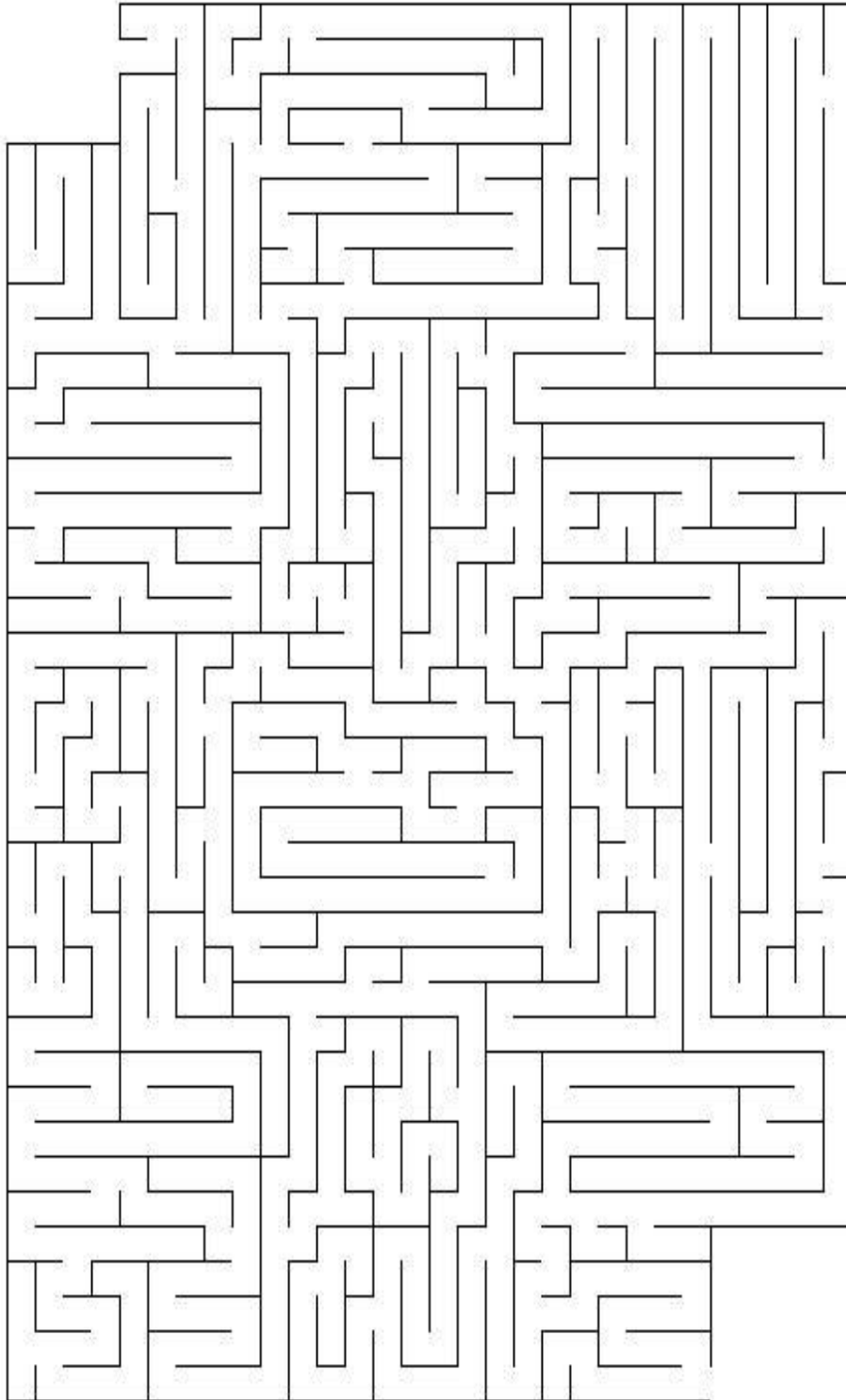

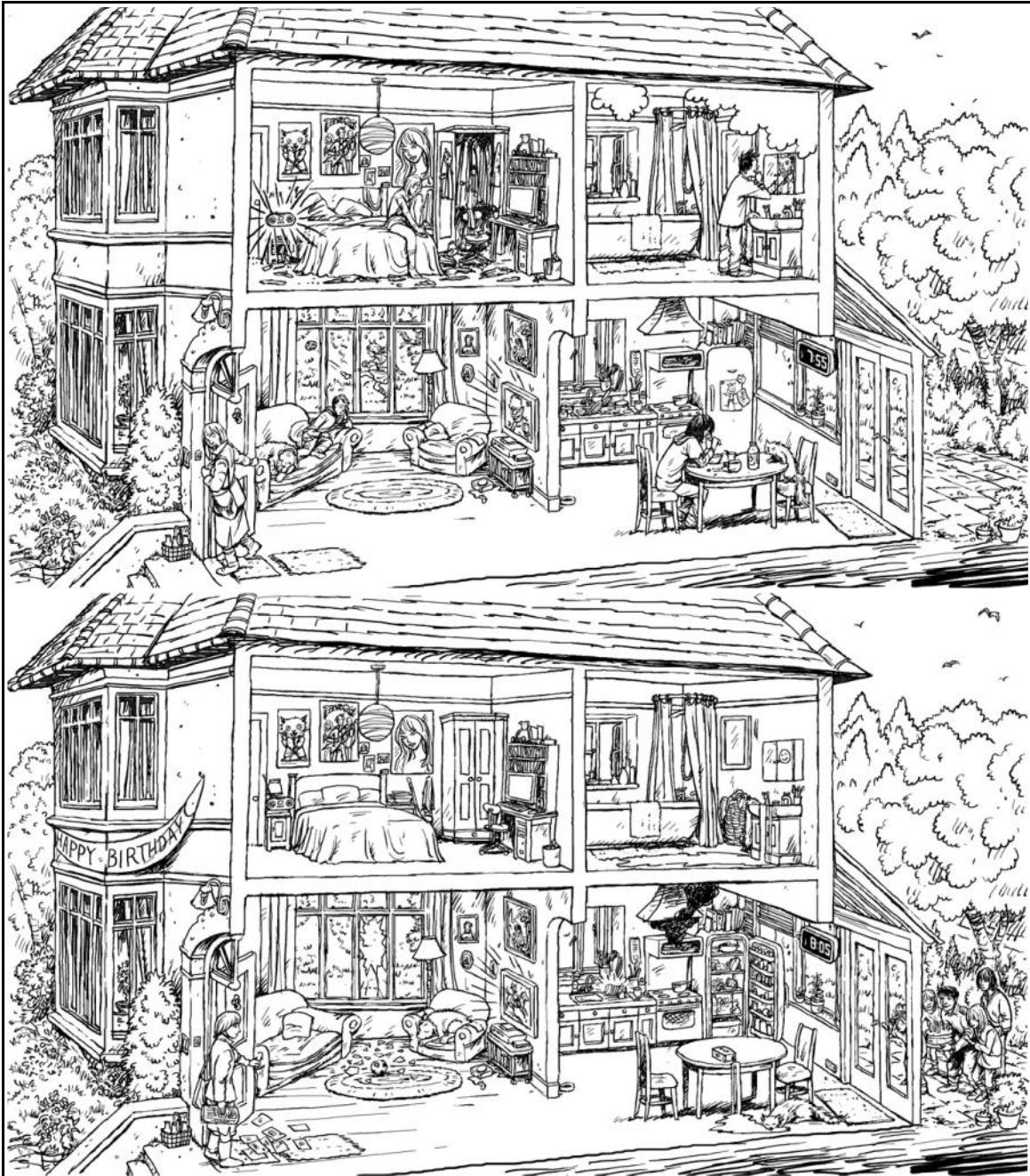
## Pets Logic Puzzle
