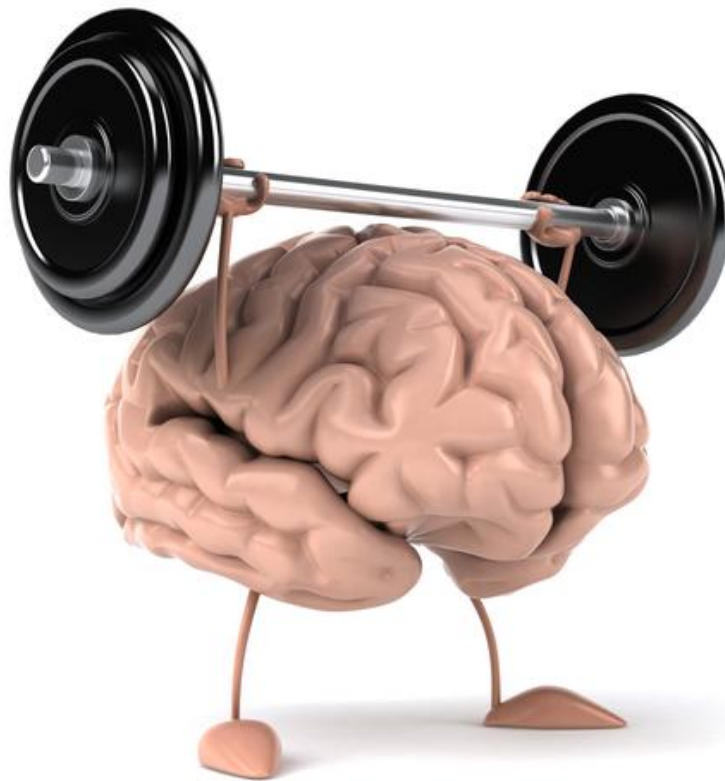

Include *A.M.* or *P.M.* in your answer (for example, *11:58 A.M.*).












Bird House Builder

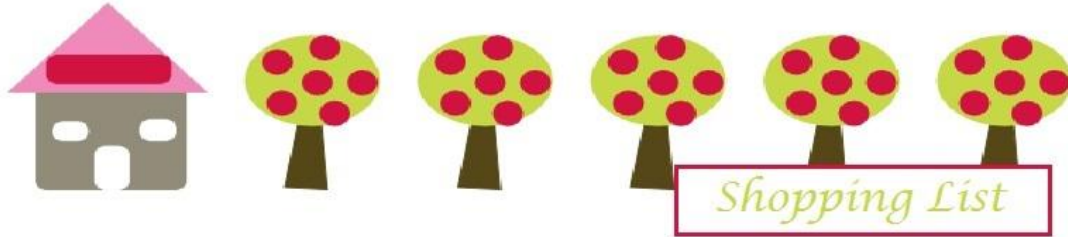


You are planning on building four of the bird houses shown above. How much wood do you need to build one house? To build four houses how much wood do you need?

Dot Painting

The Australian aborigines had many different art forms. One art form was dot painting. Dot painting consists of various paint colors like yellow (representing the sun), brown (the soil), red (desert sand) and white (the clouds and the sky). These are traditional Aboriginal colors. Dot paintings can be painted on anything though in aboriginal times they were painted on rocks, in caves, etc. The paintings were mostly images of animals or lakes, and the dreamtime. Stories and legends were depicted on caves and rocks to represent the artists' religion.
